## NGONYE FALLS

## LOCATION

The site is located in Western Province, Sioma District at latitude 16°39'15"S and longitude 23°34'2"E.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The site presents a unique formation similar to that of the Victoria Falls. The site was formed as a result of volcanic eruptions in Botswana that created the basaltic rocks which are now eroded by the power of water creating the drop for the waterfall. The site is spectacular and has great potential for tourism development as it is on the way to Sioma Gwezi National Park.

## BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

The described area measures approximately 10,877 hectares.

The described area is shown on a plan marked red, signed by the Surveyor-General and deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General and the National Heritage Conservation Commission, Lusaka.
