IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 2 of the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, and after approval by the Emoluments Commission, the following Regulations are made:

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| 1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Regulations, 2024. | Title and commencement |
| (2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 2024. | |
| 2. There shall be paid to the holder of an office specified in the Schedule, a salary and allowances set out in the Schedule. | Salary and allowances |
| 3. The Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Regulations, 2018 are revoked. | Revocation of S.I. No. 64 of 2018 |
